

**COVID-19 RALLY PROTOCOL**  
**REVISED 31<sup>ST</sup> July 2021**

**ALTHOUGH ALL RESTRICTIONS IN ENGLAND HAVE BEEN LIFTED SOME MEASURES ARE PUT IN PLACE FOR YOUR SAFETY, THE SAFETY OF OTHER RALLIERS AND YOUR RALLY OFFICERS AND IS IN COMPLIANCE WITH THE RISK ASSESSMENT COMPLETED TO ALLOW THE RALLY TO PROCEED.**

PLEASE ENSURE YOU BRING WITH YOU AN AMPLE SUPPLY OF HAND SANITISER AND ANTI BACTERIAL WIPES. PLEASE REMEMBER SOCIAL DISTANCING AT ALL TIMES AND REGULARLY WASH HANDS FOR 20 SECONDS

**ON ARRIVAL** - Please stop at the Rally Office.

You will then be shown to a peg but please try to keep to social distancing. Rally Officers will ensure a minimum of 6 metres between vans but, space permitting will try to allow even more than the 6 metres.

You will now receive an envelope containing welcome sheet, Competition etc. but no Plaque until 2022.

**ON THE RALLY –**

**SOCIALLY DISTANCED SOCIALS IN ENCLOSED SPACES ARE NOW PERMISSIBLE - THIS INCLUDES FLAG. TEA, COFFEE AND BISCUITS WILL NOT BE AVAILABLE SO PLEASE BRING YOUR OWN DRINKS AND SNACKS. VISITORS ARE NOW ALLOWED ON THE RALLY FIELD BUT MUST REPORT TO THE RALLY OFFICE FOR TEST AND TRACE RECORDING**

There will be no Club and Centre Equipment available for purchase

No under 16 year old to use the water tap and Ralliers to use their own water pipe and clean taps/service points BEFORE & AFTER use with the antibacterial wipes you have brought with you.

Rally Officers are not expected to police the policy which is in accordance with the Risk Assessment prepared to enable this Rally to proceed - any report of breach of this protocol to be dealt with in accordance with the Centre Rules.

All dry waste to be taken home unless landowner provides alternative safe disposal facilities

New signage will be available reminding ralliers of the need to wash hands for 20 seconds.
