VICE-CHAIRMANS MESSAGE

Dear Members,

Well, this is not the Chairman's Message I wanted to write.

The last 12 months have been a difficult time for the Centre, we have seen a fall in the numbers of our members attending rallies, which is really disappointing for the Rally Officers who have given their time to host a rally, also we have struggled to get members willing to organise rallies which has resulted in a depleted Rally Programme for 2024.

Early in the year Barbara informed the Committee that after over 30 years in office as Treasurer, she would be retiring at the 2023 AGM. As we could not find her a replacement, we had to consider the best options available for the Centre. Following a committee decision that we did not want to go into hibernation, we reached out to the Cumbria Centre and after a of couple meetings agreed the possibility of a merger for the two Centre's. You will find on both centre websites the Rally Programme for 2024, which will show the rallies/events within each centre, there will be an appropriate link to Cumbria Centre regarding booking for their rallies.

Should this be the final year of the North Lancashire Centre, I personally ask you all to support as many of the events as possible and if you would like to host a rally or an event, it isn't too late! Please contact me, the Rally Secretary, or any Committee member for advice.

Personally, North Lancs has been a special club in my life and have made lifelong friends along the way. With so many happy memories, I am looking forward to the next chapter for the Centre. There will be more rallies and events to choose from and new friends to make along the way too!
